INFORMATION AND RULES FOR MAIN SHOW

SECTIONS 1-9 INFORMATION

1. Entries are to be received on the day, Saturday 24th October, from 7.30am till 9.30am at the Public Hall.
2. There will be three entry desks operating in the foyer. Volunteers will be on hand to assist with any queries of support you require through the entry process.
3. Children's and School entries can be delivered after school on Friday 23rd until 5pm.
4. **Please fill out the entry form prior to arrival to streamline the entry process.**
5. Adult competition entries at \$2 and Junior \$1. Correct change would be appreciated.
6. Section Managers will top up water after initial set-up. All care and no responsibility by the organizers.
7. Cut flowers, vegetables & pot plants to be grown by the entrants.
8. Roses to be named where possible.
9. Floral Art need not be grown by the exhibitor.
10. Only entries in sections 1-7 will be considered for "Best in Show" award. (To be awarded at 3pm on Sunday)
11. All judges' decisions are final, and awards do not have to be given in each section.
12. Entries need to be collected by 4.15pm to enable pack up to begin.

RULES FOR SECTIONS 1-9

14. **Vases / Containers need to be provided by the exhibitor.**
15. Vase: Height greater than width.
16. Jar: Height greater than width.
17. Basket: round, square, rectangular no greater than 30cm.
18. Floral Art, Australian Natives, Junior & Pot Plants: Plant height must not exceed 70cm and plant width must not exceed 50cm *except where 'no size restriction' is stated * (Class 38).
19. Floral Art: Class 37 Min Height 50cm
20. Floral Art: No artificial or silk flowers. Exception for Class 33 where the flowers must be in a hand-made in different medium (no real flowers).
21. Junior entries must not exceed 30cm in diameter or 20cm in height unless stated otherwise.
Class 50 – Diorama no bigger than 30cm in any direction.
22. Pot Plants no heavier than 5 kg.
23. Pot Plants: Cactus/Succulent can be multiple.
24. Australian Natives: **Proteas/Leucadendrons are not natives.**
25. Junior Categories are for 16 years old and under.
26. Jams and Preserves: Lids to be used no sealing wax/cellophane, Jars will be opened and tasted.
27. Jams and Preserves: to be homemade by entrant & variety must be clearly labelled with ingredients, date cooked and marked **HOT** if chili included
28. Jam jars to be 250g in size or less, chutney, relish & preserves



INFORMATION AND RULES FOR CAKE DECORATING & PHOTO COMPETITIONS

Entries to be delivered to the Public Hall between 3.00pm - 5.30pm Friday 23rd October.

We are unable to accept late entries due to the timing of judging.

Entries must be picked up by 4.15pm on Sunday 25th unless special arrangements have been made with the committee beforehand.

Competition Entry Fees: \$2 Adults, \$1 Junior – 16 years and under.

CAKES

1. Cakes are to be decorated as per the theme on the schedule.
1. Entrants need to provide a labelled cover for their entries for overnight protection.
2. Entries will be judged on the evening of the 23rd of October.
3. Bases maximum dimension: 25cm/10 inch and will not be cut.
4. Ribbons may be awarded for 1st, 2nd 3rd places.
5. Cake bases can consist of tins, blocks, and other materials in place of cake.

PHOTOS

1. Entries must be mounted on **firm board (not Cover Paper)**, not framed.
2. Entries must be A3 size or under, which can include a border.
3. Entries will be judged on the evening of Friday 23rd October.
4. Ribbons may be awarded for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places in each section.
5. Other than slight lighting adjustments, computer alteration of images, additions etc. are not to be used.
